### R. Müller, 2010 Riesling

The R. Müller 'Rabbit' Riesling (aka 'The Bunny Wine') was produced from grapes grown in the Landwein Rhein region of Germany. The wines of this region continue to impress Riesling lovers as they are known for elevating wines with a little more body and this 2010 Riesling is a nice example. With a nose of peaches and pears that follows to the palate and finishes with a nice crispness, this wine leaves you longing for another sip. It is a perfect match for firm cheeses, pastas with cream sauce, lighter seafood dishes and Asian cuisine.

### Winemakers Notes:

"Harvested at night, the wine is gently pressed and clarified before fermentation. The wine was then fermented in stainless steel tanks at low temperatures and with specially selected yeast to maximize the aromatic intensity."
